

## **Scoot to Kick Off Brand New Malaysian Destinations**

### **Scoot has launched ticket sales for two new Malaysian destinations, introduces promotional fares**

*Singapore* – Scoot has launched ticket sales for Kuching and Kuantan, bringing the total number of Scoot destinations in Malaysia to six cities including Ipoh, Kuala Lumpur, Langkawi and Penang.

Scoot will be operating daily flights from Singapore to Kuching starting 29 October 2017 and three times weekly flights from Singapore to Kuantan from 2 February 2018.

Kuching and Kuantan are among the five new destinations announced on 25 July 2017 in conjunction with the completion of the Scoot-Tigerair integration under the single Scoot brand. The other three are Honolulu, Scoot's maiden USA destination, Harbin in Northeast China, and Palembang in Indonesia.

We will continue to identify opportunities to bring our unique travel experience, also known as "Scootitude", to more guests in the region."
